Concept

- One-day training for young professionals (3-5 years of professional experience) in the roles of Supply Chain, Sales, Purchasing, and Finance
- Competition between teams from different companies
- Use of the business simulation "The Blue Connection"





Concept

- Simulation of real challenges in transforming a linear into a circular supply chain
- Participating company teams compete against each other
- Competition for the best return on investment (ROI)
- Prize for the winning team





Challenges


- Manage capacities, resources, and interfaces
- Experience and utilize the interconnections between sales, purchasing, finances, and supply chain
- Collaborate across departments
- Recognize the relevance of information exchange for making correct decisions
- Correctly evaluate existing information





Challenges


- Identify and implement potential improvements
- Define, evaluate, implement, and analyze supply chain transformation and circular processes and collaborations
- Ensure cross-departmental and functional collaboration
- Take responsibility for the effects of all decisions made for the entire company





Learning Goals

- Make decisions as a team
- Quickly capture and analyze data
- Question the weighting of individual goals to maximize the overall result
- Train deliberate action through clear role distribution in Supply Chain, Sales, Purchasing, and Finance
- Prioritize important decisions under time pressure
- Develop social skills
- Promote teamwork and networked thinking and highlight it as a competitive advantage
- Take learning experiences back to the company as a team

Price: 2.995 € + VAT per team (with min. 3 and max. 4 participants)

Services:

- One-day, German-speaking event "Young Professionals Challenge (YPC)" on "Supply Chain Transformation & Circularity"
- **Debriefing** of the decisions made and their impact in the business simulation with each team individually and via web conference after the event (duration 45 minutes). The date will be arranged individually with each team.
- Participation in the SPRING or AUTUMN edition of the online competition "The Fresh Connection Global PRO Challenge" (3 weeks, 3 rounds in May or October)
- Qualification for the online competition "The Fresh Connection Global PRO Challenge", in which teams from more than 30 countries participate in the finals in November annually. The winning teams from the SPRING or AUTUMN edition (as above) are invited to the remote finals in November, where they compete for the main prize of the challenge:
 leadership training for the entire team (for the top 3 teams).
- The winning team of the Young Professionals Challenge receives free access for each team member for 1 year to PMI's Supply Chain Academy (eLearning courses).


 Setup: One-day event, from 09:00am to 05:00pm, followed by networking with snacks and drinks until 06:00pm
